"Amen" means "I really believe." That is why we answer "Amen" when we receive Jesus in the Eucharist. Here are some prayers to say aloud. Say them with care and respect.

I believe God loves everyone. Amen.

I believe Jesus is the Son of God. Amen.

I believe Jesus shows us how to love. Amen.

I believe Jesus is in the Eucharist. Amen.

I believe Jesus died on the cross. Amen.

I believe Jesus rose from the dead. Amen.

I believe Jesus sent the Holy Spirit to help us. Amen.

Now add a short prayer for people who need our help.

Family Note: Your child is learning about the Eucharist Meal. You can do this activity as a family whenever it is convenient for you. Choose a leader or take turns reading the statements of belief with everyone responding "Amen." If you wish, individual family members could also mention a statement to which everyone responds, "Amen."
