**1. Read Mark 2: 1-12**

2. After reading, consider the connections between the images of healing offered in this story and the Church's sacraments of healing-Penance and Reconciliation and Anointing of the Sick. Catholics believe we experience:
  - a. Spiritual healing- if we have faith like the paralytic and are humbly sorry for our sins.
  - b. Healing when we are ill and suffering-even if we are not physically healed like the paralytic, we can be strengthened to deal with our sickness and comforted by God's love.
3. Reflection questions – answer in 1-2 paragraphs
  - a. Do you consider yourself a forgiving person? Why or why not?
  - b. How do you feel when you are forgiven by someone?

1. Read Mark 2: 13-17.
2. If you were hosting a dinner in Jesus's honor, who would you invite to be there with you? Why?
3. Which groups in society today are not welcomed by a majority of people or who may struggle to find a group of friends. Why is that?
